ITINERARY DETAIL

Day 1 — Day 1: Bangkok arrival (-)

Warmly welcome you on arrival at Bangkok Suvarnabhumi International Airport. We will pick you up with a comfortable vehicle to check-in your hotel, then take your time to have a rest after a long flight.

Overnight in Bangkok

Day 2 — Day 2: Bangkok- Hua Hin (55 km) (B, L, D)

Morning our experience tour guide will meet you at your hotel and we will start to cycle to Hua Hin, is *well-known for its traditional fishing port, seafood restaurants and beautiful sandy beach. It is ideal for families and for all those who want to escape the hustle and bustle of big cities.*

Stop on the way for a visit to a cave in Petchaburi town. We then continue for an hour until reach your resort. From your resort we enjoy a leisure ride to a beautiful lake.

You also will pass through the farms and plantations then stop to visit **Wat Huay Mongkhon**, an unique architectural structure with distinct styles. Especially, there is the largest statue of Luang Phor Thuad in the world. Luang Phor Thuad is a famous monk in southern Thailand who is able to perform miracles.

Back to your hotel for your relax at the resort pool.

Day 3 — Day 3: Hua Hin- Kuiburi (86 km) (B, L, D)

After breakfast at the resort, we will depart for the next leg of our cycling adventure, heading south along some of the new specially built cycle paths to wards **Prachuap Kiri Khan**, *a fishing port located in the heart of an exceptional bay.*

During this day of cycling you will ride along through national parks. The leg of the journey will see you leaving the large tourist area of Hua Hin and head into less visited areas where you have chance to see the real life of Thailand.

In the afternoon (optional) Elephant Safari to the **Kuiburi National Park**, known as the best place in Thailand to detect elephants and a good opportunity to discover gaurs.

Day 4 — Day 4: Prachuap Kiri Khan (B, L, D)

Today we will cycle to an army base, on the way stop to a large pineapple plantations. Your tour guide will explain how to grow and export it.

After lunch we will continue towards **Haad Baan Krut**, passing small rural villages and the **Wat Tang Sai Temple**. Your accommodation for the night will be the Sunshine Paradise Resort

Day 5 — Day 5: Haad-Baan-Krut - Chumphon (140 km) (B, L, D)

After breakfast we will start our journey along the beachside passing through a large Buddha sitting on the top of a steep hill with great panoramic views.

Lunch will be served at a Thai Wooden House.

Upon arrival at your hotel, you will be free at your own pleasure to relax or swim.

Overnight at the hotel in Chumphon

Day 6 — Day 6: Thai cooking class (B)

After a long journey we will have a rest day to recover and you have chance to join in one of our special activity: Join our Thai Cooking Class, you can take a deep look into how Thai people approach cooking and of course how much they spend daily.

The rest of day would be spent at your own pleasure to enjoy the beautiful surroundings

Day 7 — Day 7: Chumphon - Paktako (94 km) (B, L, D)

Morning after breakfast, we will have a half day cycling to Paktako. On the way we stop to visit past shrimp farms, coconut plantations and mangrove forests.

You also will pass through several fishing villages where you can take the beautiful pictures of colored fishing boats. In the afternoon you will spend your rest of time by the resort pool or swimming on the beach.

Day 8 — Day 8: Paktako - Surat-Thani (169 km) (B, L, D)

Today we continue cycling south along the beach to the less visited areas. Our journey leads to Chaiya, one of the oldest cities in Thailand.

Lunch will be on the beach and for the last 55km to Surat-Thani you can do it by bike or on our support van.

Day 9 — Day 9: Surat-Thani - Cheow lake (82 km) (B, L, D)

After breakfast we depart for **Cheow Lan Lake**. Arrive at pier then board on Long Tail boat to cruise the turquoise water of Cheow Larn Lake.

Start journey back by long tail boat, spotted Chaew-Lan Lake Scenic View.

Day 10 — Day 10: Ratchapraha - Phuket (59 km) (B, L)

We leave the beautiful lake landscape by boat. On small, scenic roads we cycle south along the Klong Phanom National Park to the temple named Wat Bang Rieng, one of the most beautiful in southern Thailand.

Finally our van will drive you to Phuket where you will end your cycling journey and enjoy your last few days on the beautiful beach of Thailand

Day 11 — Day 11: Phuket beach free & easy (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Your time of today will be on your own or you might want to practice swimming, diving; enjoy the seafood or have fun in the bars.
